01 ► Eminent Marathi writer, RC Dhere, passed away at the age of 86. He was a recipient of the Sahitya Akademi Award in 1987.

02 ► Former French Socialist Prime Minister, Michel Rocard, died at the age of 85. Rocard, a fervent advocate of the European Union, served as Prime Minister under President Francois Mitterrand from 1988 to 1991.

03 ► Mercedes driver Lewis Hamilton, hailing from Great Britain won the 2016 Austrian Grand Prix title of Formula 1 at the Red Bull Ring, Spielberg (Austria).

04 ► Abbas Kiarostami, the critically acclaimed Iranian director, died at the age of 76. His 1997 film 'Taste of Cherry' won the prestigious Palme d'Or Award at the Cannes Film Festival.

05 ► The researchers from the University of Leuven (KU Leuven) in Belgium have built a sensitive electronic nose with Metal-Organic Frameworks (MOFs) that can detect pesticides and nerve gas in very low concentrations.

06 ► Rajasthan became the first state in India to introduce minimum wages for part-time workers.

07 ► The National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM) unveiled India's first Centre of Excellence focussed on Internet of Things (CoE-IoT) at its Startup Warehouse in Bengaluru.

08 ► Department of Commerce, Government of India established an Apparel Training Centre in Kaduna, Nigeria under the Cotton Technical Assistance Programme (Cotton TAP) for Africa under second India Africa Forum Summit. The Centre was inaugurated on June 22, 2016.

09 ► The 2-day long NATO Summit concluded in Warsaw (Poland). It was the 27th biannual summit of NATO since its inception in 1949.

10 ► Andy Murray (UK) won his second Wimbledon men's singles title after beating Milos Raonic (Canada) in straight sets.

12 ► KVR Murthy took over as Chairman-cum-Managing Director of the Jute Corporation of India Limited.

13 ► INS-India, the base depot ship at New Delhi, celebrated its 75th anniversary. Established as HMIS India in 1941, it was rechristened as INS-India on January 26, 1950.

14 ► Jayshree Mukherjee, got appointed as Additional Secretary in Information and Broadcasting Ministry.

15 ► Dabur India inked a MoU with DRDO, Defence Institute of High Altitude Research, to promote sustainable cultivation of rare medicinal plants in Ladakh, which is one of the most difficult terrains in the world.

16 ► Vijendra Singh, clinched the WBO Asia Pacific Super Middleweight Boxing title at the Thyagraj Stadium, New Delhi, after defeating former WBC European champion Kerry Hope.

17 ► Chowna Mein sworn-in as the Deputy Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh. He administered the oath by Governor Tathagata Roy at the Rajbhavan in Itanagar.

18 ► Legendary singer, Mubarak Begum, passed away at the age of 80. She is remembered for singing scores of songs, duets and ghazals for Bollywood, mainly during the 1950s-1970s.

20 ► The Election Commission of India launched **National Electoral Roll Purification (NERP) 2016** programme across the country to improve health of Electoral Rolls (ERs) and to optimise the Polling Station (PS) location and area across the country.

21 ► The Lok Sabha passed the **NIT-Science Education and Research (Amendment) Bill, 2016**. The bill passed by voice vote, seeks to establish the NIT, Andhra Pradesh as an institute of national importance under the National Institutes of Technology, Science Education and Research (NITSER) Act, 2007.
